	 Noise Monitor update (as per Action Item) Airservices are continuing negotiations with landowners for three installation sites for the new noise monitors: A noise monitor is in the process of being installed at Our Lady's College, Annerley – it is expected to be operational within the next few weeks Preliminary approval has been given for a Brisbane City Council site at Salisbury and is under finalisation The final site is still being finalised but is likely to be in the Toowong area Airservices will continue to advise the CACG as more information is available.
